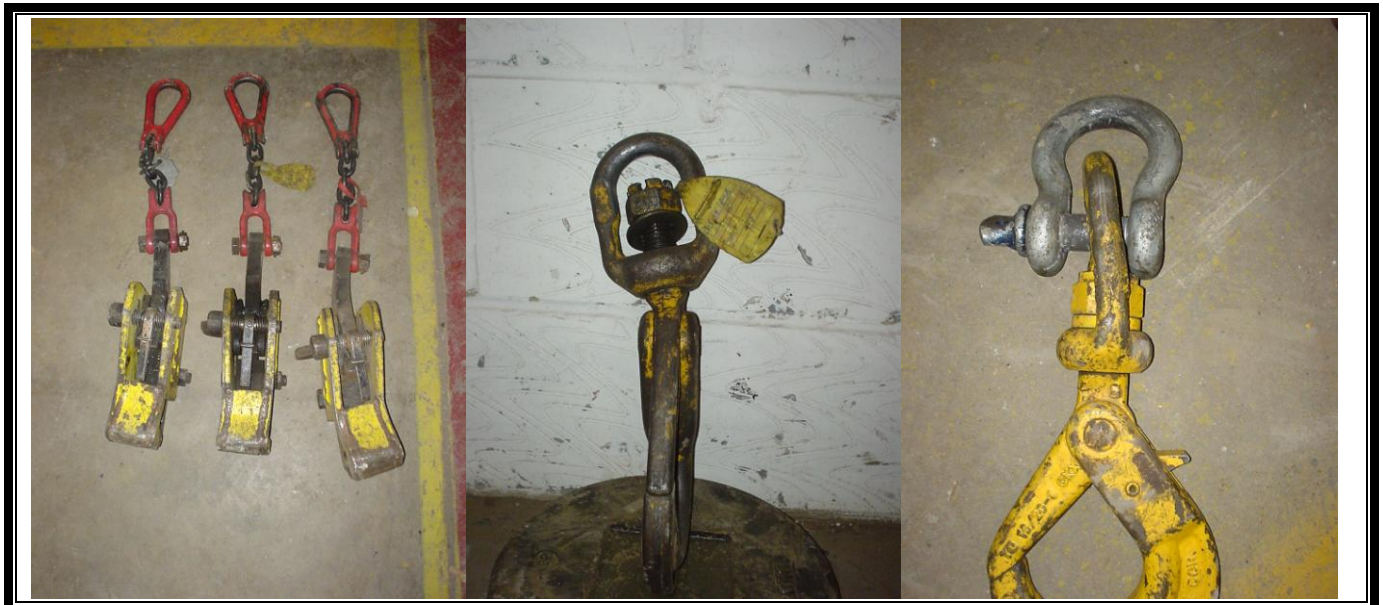

## SAFETY BRIEFING

### Unsafe and Destructive Use of Attachments

Below are examples of lifting attachments that are due to be condemned and replaced at cost to Readypower. We were not notified that the items were damaged by any operator until they were recovered to our depot.



By looking at the type of damage inflicted, it can be deduced what task was being done at the time they failed. It is clear that some of the attachments were also used for tasks that they were not originally designed for.

Readypower's Policy is simple:

1. Do not use an attachment for any other purpose than it has been designed for, even if you are asked by the customer. The customer is responsible for ordering the correct plant for the job.

### **IF ITS NOT SAFE, DON'T DO IT**

2. If any damage occurs on site for whatever reason you must report it immediately to the on-call manager and get the damage signed for by the customer on your timesheet.
3. The company will not tolerate unreported damage to any item of plant or attachment. If damage can be traced back to an individual who has not previously reported it, then that individual will be subject to full disciplinary action and dismissal.
