PTS Work Experience Log Books

From December 2010 a new version of NR/L2/CTM/021 standard states that it requires the holder of Track Safety competences to record **4 entries** in their work experience books per year prior to attending a recertification event or annual review (Network Rail). As the standard is published and compliant from 4 December 2010 it may not be possible for all delegates attending a recertification event or annual review to have the sufficient entries and for this reason an extension will be granted to all Track Safety Competence holders to comply with these requirements.

A person attending a recertification event or annual review between 4th December and the 28th February 2011 only needs to have recorded **2 entries** in each of the previous two years.

An example being:

- Recertification event (annual review) held during December 2010
- Two entries in the year required between December 2008 and December 2009
- Two entries in the year required between December 2009 and December 2010

All competence holders from 1st March 2011 will need to comply with the new issue of the standard.

An example:

- Recertification event (annual review) held during March 2011
- Two entries required in the year between March 2009 and March 2010
- Four entries required in the year between March 2010 and March 2011

Remember, all entries are to be signed off by the relevant person stipulated in the log book and current log books do not indicate the change to four entries per year being needed.
