TOOLBOX

Restrictions are in place across the project which means that Red Zone working is not allowed on the NLRIP unless special permission has been given. This also applies to access arrangements to and from sites if in a Red Zone.

A Red Zone is defined as 'a site of work near or on the line, which is not protected from train movements'

You must not undertake any form of Red Zone working or access unless;

- Special permission has been given and this has been confirmed by your Line Manager.
- The Rimini Plan covers the Red Zone working or access/egress arrangements.

The COSS will be responsible for the safe system of work and briefing all team members on the arrangements.

Infringement of these rules will result in disciplinary action.
